What does it mean to “hallow” (worship) the name of God according to your natural or God-given spiritual DNA?

1. **Enthusiasts** (Psalm 100:1-2, Psalm 9:11)
2. **Sensate** (1Kings 7&8)
3. **Activists** (Acts 6:1-7, John 8:1-11)
4. **Ascetics** (Galatians 1:18, 2:1 Luke 4:1)
5. **Contemplatives** (Psalm 46:10, Psalm 51:10-12, John 4:24)
6. **Intellectuals** (Romans 12:2, Matt 22:37)
7. **Caregivers** (James 1:27)
8. **Naturalists** (Isaiah 40:21-31)
9. **Traditionalists** (I Cor. 14:33)

Welcoming the presence of God into corporate worship includes participation that goes beyond your DNA!
