



NORTH WAY FOOD PANTRY OUTREACHES

1. We are able to help a domestic violence center for women and children by giving them food for the women and children who are staying at this facility.
2. We provide much needed food to a local safe house for rescued victims of sex trafficking.
3. We provide food directly to rescued victims of sex and labor trafficking.
4. We bless several low income senior centers on a regular basis.
5. We give "Outreached Arms" fresh produce, bread and desserts to feed the homeless in the downtown area.
6. We help St. Richard's Catholic Church in Gibsonia with their ministry of feeding the homeless on the North Side several times a month.
7. We give a middle school class in Shaler some of our abundance of produce so that their "Life Skills Class" for the mentally challenged is able to learn to make banana bread, apple sauce, apple cobbler, and smoothies so that they feel capable of providing for themselves some day
8. We give our surplus bread to the Urban League, and they distribute it to many impoverished families.
9. We take surplus bread to a food pantry located in a church in West View.
10. We are able to help a "Honey Lunch Program" (in a very impoverished area in West Virginia) provide healthy, wholesome food for elementary school children when they go home for the weekend. This organization makes sure the children have nourishing food while they are at home – thanks to donations from Whole Foods!
11. We help a food bank in an impoverished area in Wheeling, WV, with food, clothing, house wares and toys.
12. We send food, clothing and toys to Moundsville, WV, where many are helped. This year, one of their greatest needs, other than food, were warm coats. Many of the food pantry volunteers donated gently used coats for the families.
13. The "Flower Children" (consisting of 10 food pantry volunteers) take flowers from Trader Joe's to nursing homes, hospices, senior centers, and assisted living facilities every Saturday and Sunday. The Flower Children bring joy everywhere they go!
14. One volunteer picks up from Whole Foods every Friday, and has a ministry of her own that feeds several large families who are struggling.
15. We will begin supplying our surplus bread and produce to a new ministry in Mars that is feeding the homeless and poor in that area.
16. Along with One Warm Coat/One New Toy, we helped a ministry of North Catholic High School that provided a meal and toys for Christmas to the Troy Hill area of the North Side.
17. Every summer, we take surplus fruit and veggies to the Pine Valley Camp north of Zelienople. The cooks at the camp make something with every piece of produce that we provide. We also give them bread and desserts for the campers.
18. Surplus bread and desserts is passed along to Little Sisters of the Poor.
19. We provide boxes of "emergency food" to people who come to the church office seeking food.
20. "Care packages" of donated fruit, vegetables, bread, desserts and prepared foods are boxed every weekend for approximately 20 North Way members who pick up the food after attending one of the three services in Wexford.
21. And most important -- we provide the food bank to the Wexford, Bradford Woods, Valencia and Richland areas of our community, as well as members who attend North Way Christian Community.
