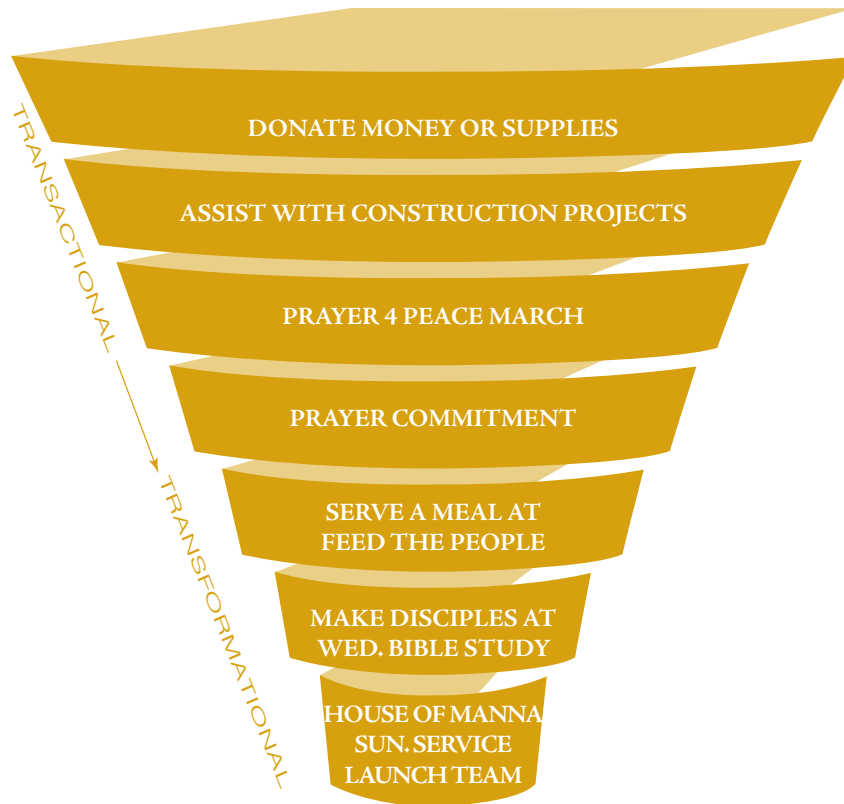


HOUSE OF MANNA



Prayer Needs: North Way partners with the House of Manna Faith Community in Homewood. House of Manna seeks to share the Gospel and make disciples throughout the Homewood community.

- Pray for the leadership of House of Manna as they follow God in this ministry.
- Pray for the people of Homewood served by the Faith Community.
- Pray about how your group can partner with House of Manna and God's work through its ministry.

Descriptions of Volunteer Opportunities:

Donate Money or Supplies – *One-time or occasional opportunity* – House of Manna is in need of financial support as they work to launch their Sunday services. They also need craft supplies, games, and other items for their kids and student ministry spaces. Small groups can join together to collect supplies or make a one-time financial gift to the ministry.

Assist with Construction Projects – *One-time or occasional opportunity* – As the House of Manna continues to build their ministry, ongoing renovations are needed at their facility in Homewood. Interested groups can commit a Saturday of working together to help make the House of Manna ministry center a blessing to the Homewood community.

Prayer 4 Peace March – *Annual event* – Each year on Good Friday, House of Manna organizes the Prayer 4 Peace March in Pittsburgh. Believers from the House of Manna join with those from other churches from around Pittsburgh to demonstrate unity among Christ's followers in support for peace and reconciliation in Homewood. Groups could join this event as a display of God's love for the Homewood community.

Prayer Commitment – *Ongoing need* – "Pray in the Spirit at all times, with every kind of prayer and petition" (Ephesians 6:18). Commit to praying for the House of Manna Faith Community and the people of Homewood on a weekly or monthly basis as a group. Pray about how each individual in your group can be used by God to help impact this part of our city, one life at a time.

Serve a Meal at Feed the People – *Monthly opportunity* – On the 4th Friday of every month, the House of Manna hosts a dinner in Homewood to feed those who are hungry. Groups can sign up to help prepare and serve this meal. This can begin as a one-time activity and could grow into a monthly or bi-monthly commitment.

Make Disciples at Wednesday Bible Study – *Weekly commitment* – House of Manna hosts a weekly Bible study on Wednesdays throughout the year that is open to all in the community. There is a need for disciple makers to join this weekly group to help guide attendees in the growth of their faith.

House of Manna Sunday Service Launch Team – *Weekly commitment* – House of Manna is currently launching a Sunday service at noon each week. As they move forward with this worship service, there is a need for a core group of individuals committed to helping with all of the details that need to be accounted for to make the service a success. Groups could get on board with the launch team to actively participate in making this vision of House of Manna a reality.
